Craft Show information and Rules:

Date: Friday November 30th and Saturday December 1st, 2018

Hours: Friday 5:00 - 9:00 P.M. and Saturday 9:00 A.M. - 4:00 P.M.

Crafter Fees: \$50 for each 10'x10' space for Friday and Saturday or
Saturday only

Food & Drink Booths: \$100 for each 10'x10'.
(Drinks are allowed to be sold by food vendors ONLY)

Entry Requirements:

- 1) **All vendors' items must be handmade only. Artists and craftsmen must be present selling their own wares.** Vendors must have a state sales tax permit and are responsible for collecting, reporting, and paying all applicable taxes.
- 2) Antique dealers are welcome. No imports or reproductions. Only true antiques.
- 3) Goliad County Historical Commission reserves the right to remove any vendor at any time for violations of the regulations set forth or for selling works not submitted for approval.
- 4) Entry forms **must** be accompanied by photos representative of the kind of work to be exhibited for sale at the show. Photos must be clearly labeled with the artists name and will not be returned. Mail entry form, copy of your state tax ID certificate, photos, and payment: There will be no refunds once payment is accepted. **All tents and awnings must be securely weighed Down.**

- 5) **Booth space will not be assigned until payment is received with all required documentation as listed above.** You will receive a receipt with your booth space assignment noted and **bring this postcard with you at check in.**
- 6) Participants are responsible for their own merchandise. The Goliad County Historical Commission will not be responsible for any loss, theft, breakage, or personal injury. A security guard will be on the square over night.
- 7) Vendors participating Friday and Saturday will have priority on the square as space allows.

Saturday only vendors will be most likely be placed on the street.

- 8) Electricity is available on a first come basis; Vendors must provide long, heavy duty extension cords and duct tape so that cords crossing sidewalks can be taped down. Pigtales as for food vendors ONLY.

NO electric heater, personal coffee pots, or fans allowed.

- 9) Set up: **All participants must check-in before proceeding to their space. Vendors may check in at 1pm on Friday and at 6am on Saturday. No access to the square Until 1pm**

Check-in is located the corner of Market Street and Franklin in front of the Market House Museum. Booth spaces must be occupied by 8:00 A.M. on Saturday and vendors need to be completely set up by 9:00 A.M. Vendors are encouraged to decorate spaces in a Christmas theme. We encourage everyone to participate in Friday evening festivities as there are many shoppers before and after the lighted evening parade. All participants are responsible for the clean-up of their space.

- 10) **Vendors setting up on Friday must remove their vehicles off the square by 5:00 P.M. for the lighted parade that evening.** There is *no parking of vendor vehicles on the square from 8:30 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. on Saturday.* A trailer can be left behind your space if you are located on the square but not on the East Side of which is used to provide tables and chairs for the entertainment. Trailers cannot exceed ten (10) feet including the tongue and must be backed up to your space.

- 11) **Food Booths:** Food vendors are required by law to have a license from the Texas Department of Health, Food and Drug Safety Division. **Vendors must supply their own water.** Food vendors will be grouped in an area where tables and chairs are available for customers if possible. **One pigtail, maximum, while supply lasts with a \$40.00 refundable deposit. Deposit MUST be a separate check or cash.**

- 12) **Remember - All vehicles MUST BE REMOVED from the square prior to 5:00 P.M. on Friday**
